Shelter/ housing	There are multiple buildings and houses in the background, but they are fairly spread out.	This place is not densely populated and seems more rural than urban.
Landscape	There are many uncultivated areas in the drawing with wild bushes growing in the foreground and background.	The surrounding area does not appear to be highly populated.
Diet/health	There are cows in the foreground of the picture.	People in this area raised cattle for its meat, milk and cheese.
Transportation	There are boats and canoes on the water.	Water travel would appear to be an important method of getting to and from the community.
Community life; Economic activity	There are canoes coming and going from the fort.	Perhaps aboriginal people lived in the area and were involved in trading activities with the community.
Economic activity	There appear to be farms laid out across the water from the drawing.	This suggests significant agricultural activity in the area to feed the residents and possibly to sell to others.
